**CAUTION:** To prevent shock, only plug in lamp after lamp assembly is complete.

WARNING: This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). As a safety feature, this plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not attempt to work around this safety feature.

Before assembly, remove all parts and part packages from box. If anything is missing, please contact the retailer from which the product was purchased.

- 1. Align the two pins on the bulb with the holes in the socket. Carefully insert pins on bulb into socket. There are a total of three sockets on the flower stems. There are two bulbs (installed) in the lamp base.
- 2. Carefully slip each flower head (B) over the bulb and socket.

**CAUTION:** To prevent damage to lamp and lamp parts, do not use any chemical solvents on the lamp.

**WARNING:** Turn power off and unplug lamp before cleaning lamp.

**IMPORTANT:** Use a damp, soft cloth to clean lamp. DO NOT use any abrasive or chemical cleaners on the lamp.
