ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



WARNING: BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER AT THE MAIN FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER BOX BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTE: 1. Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirements. 2. READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS.

- 1. Attach the short threaded pipe to the mounting strap, then secure it with a washer and hex nut.
- 2. Attach the mounting strap to the outlet box by using two mounting screws.
- 3. Secure the top loop to the short threaded pipe.
- 4. Adjust the arms of the fixture according to the drawing of the package.
 - Important:
 - a. The arms should be positioned with equal distances between them.
- b. The arms should be fixed securely.
- 5. Secure the loop onto the main fixture.
- 6. Take the long threaded pipe and screw one side into the coupling, secure it with a washer and hex nut. Then slip a tube, small cap with the open side facing upward, big cap with the open side facing upward, a rubber pad and glass shade up through the long threaded pipe, secure them with another rubber pad, metal pad and hex nut.
- 7. Slide the big cover and small cover up to the glass shade and secure them with the finial.
- 8. Choose the length of the chain you need, then weave the fixture wire and the fixture grounding wire through the chain, collar and canopy.
- 9. Connect one end of the chain with the loop by using a loop lock.
- 10. Connect the other end of the chain with the top loop by using another loop lock.
- 11. Thread the fixture wire and fixture grounding wire through the top loop, short threaded pipe and mounting strap.
- 12. Pull out the outlet wires and house grounding wire from the outlet box. Make wire connections using the wire nuts:
 - ---The smooth wire (marked) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
 - ---The ridged wire (unmarked) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.
 - ---Attach the fixture grounding wire to the mounting strap with the green grounding screw. Then connect it to the house grounding wire with a wire nut.
 - Carefully put the wires back into the outlet box.
- 13. Attach the canopy to the mounting strap by inserting the top loop, then secure it with the collar.
- 14. Install bulbs (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum allowed wattage.
- 15. Turn on the power at the main fuse or circuit breaker box.

Caution: Adjust the position of the loop lock located on the loop until the whole fixture hangs straight if necessary. See Fig.1-a for detail.



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
