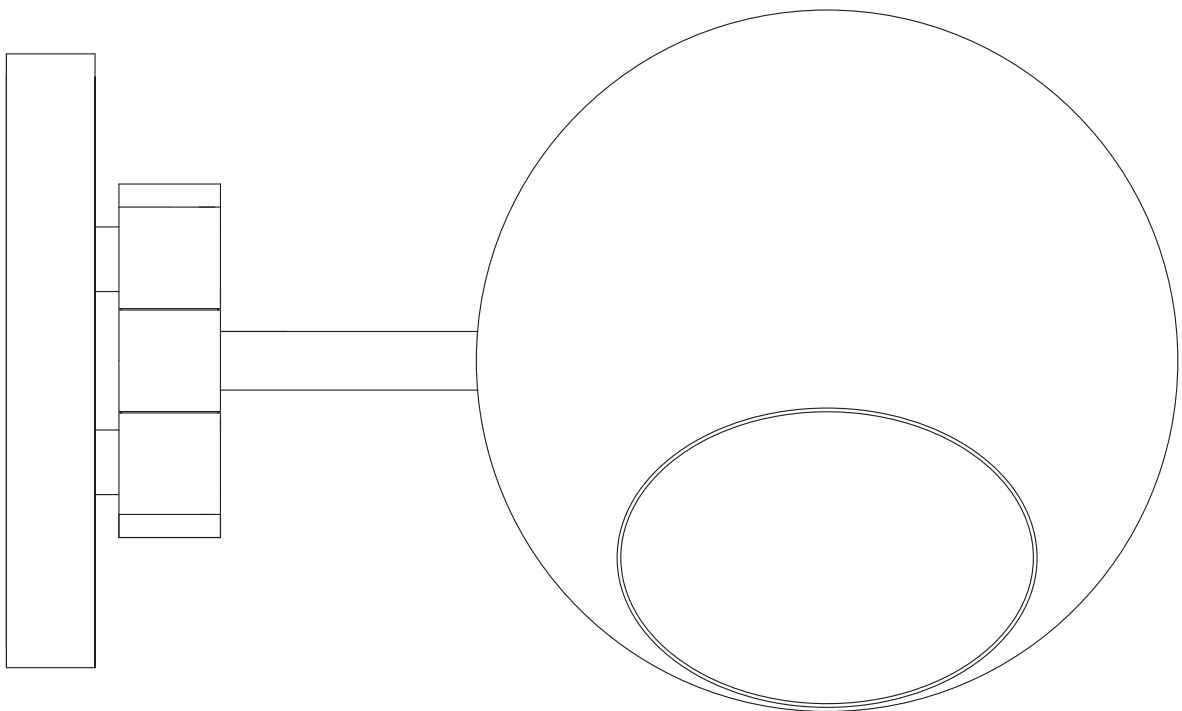

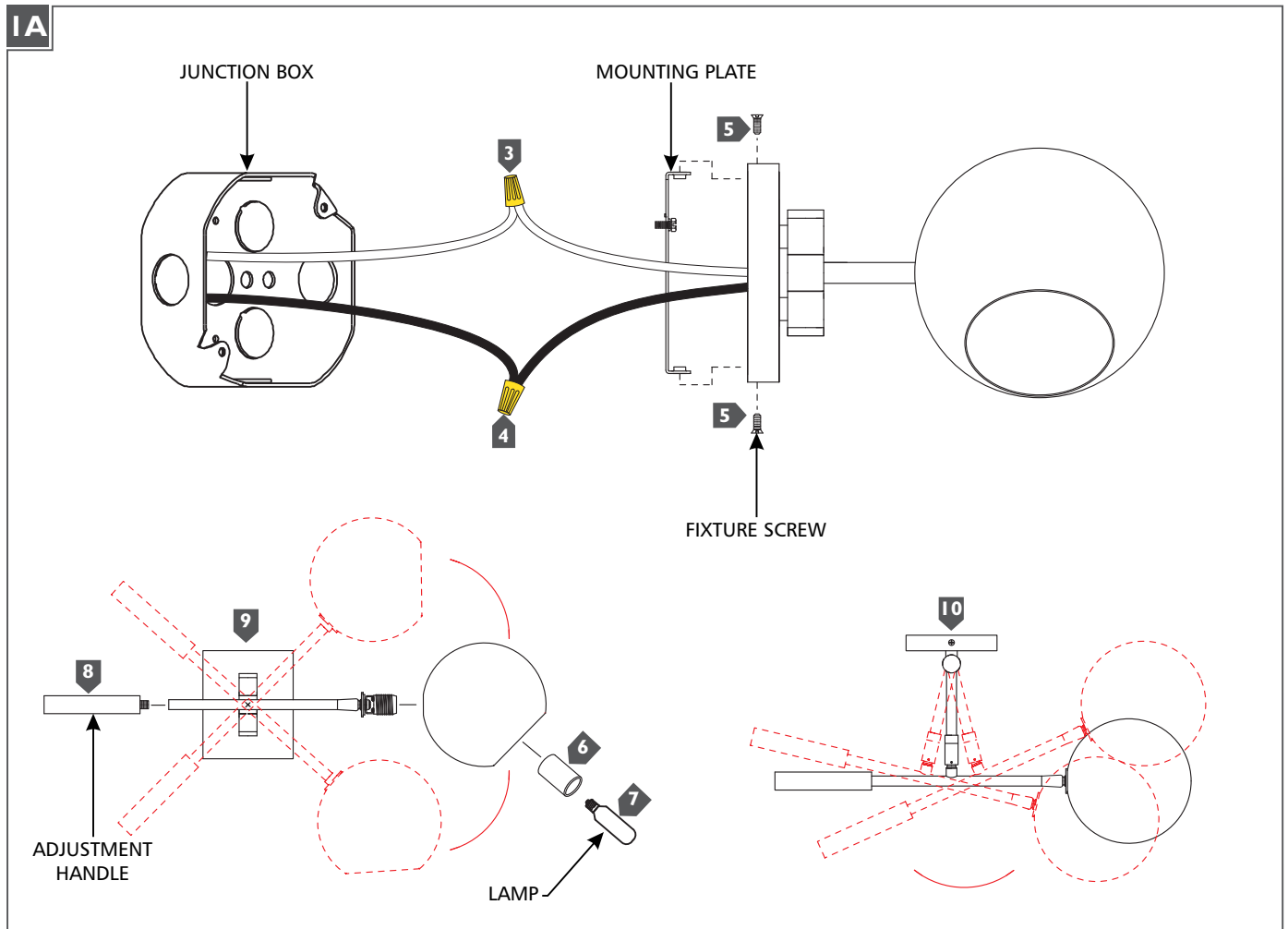

Install the Fixture



- 1** Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- 2** Connect the fixture ground wire to a suitable ground in accordance to local electrical codes.
- 3** Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 4** Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- 5** Properly place all wires and wire nut connections into the junction box/fixture base, mount the fixture onto the mounting plate, and secure it in place using the fixture screws.
- 6** Install the shade by placing it over the socket and secure it in place with the shade collar.
- 7** Screw the lamp into the socket. Refer to the label on the lamp socket for Max Wattage Information.
- 8** Screw the adjustment handle to the fixture arm.
- 9** (Optional): Adjust the lamp by using the adjustment handle to tilt the fixture up or down.
- 10** (Optional): The fixture can be aimed slightly by moving it left and right.
