

Assembly Instruction Sheet #IS-1232W30-36-A or Style 1232W30-36-A

Tools Required: Flathead screwdriver, Phillips screwdriver, pliers, 6ft X mm, 6ft Ymm 6ft Lx.

Light Source: (1) 110V LED 25W DIMMABLE E (3000K-4400K-6000K)

Estimated Assembly Time: 10-20 minutes

Preparation: Identify and inspect all parts before beginning installation. Check package content list and diagrams below to be sure all parts are present. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install, or operate the fixture. Contact customer service for replacement parts.

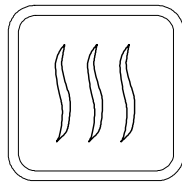
⚠ WARNING – To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock, or injury to persons:

16. Mount furnishings at the correct height.

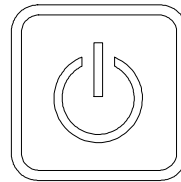
1. Débranchez toujours ce meuble de la prise électrique avant le nettoyage ou l'entretien.

- 2)  Simply tap the button to turn defogger function on/off.

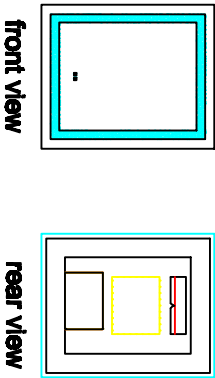

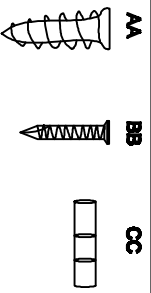

1) Loosen the screw on the Mounting bracket from the Fixture body, take off the Mounting bracket.

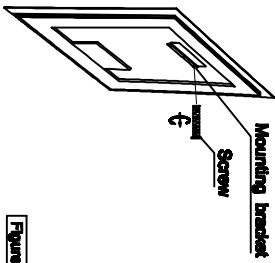

2) Measure the Distance between the holes on the back of the Mounting bracket, then remark the same distance on the wall at the same time remark the hole dots on the wall.
 1-1) Using a 10mm drill bit, drill the holes where the hole dots are.
 2-2) Install screws into Mounting bracket, as shown in the figure.

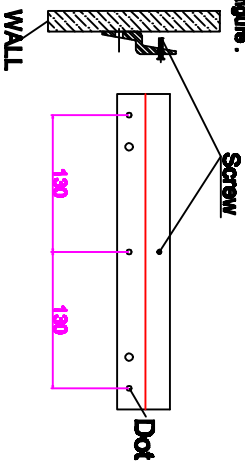

3) Using a screw driver, fix the Mounting bracket on the wall, as shown in the figure.

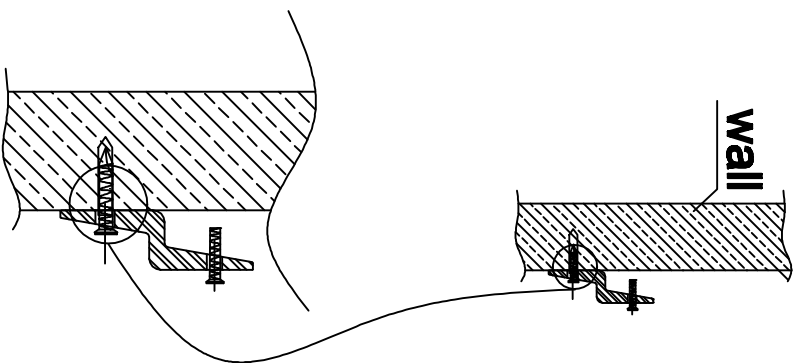

4) The positive electrode is connected to the positive electrode and the negative electrode to the negative electrode.
 (1-1) Hang the mirror on the wall, as shown in the figure.
 2-2) Make sure the Mounting bracket on the back of the mirror is aligned with the screw.

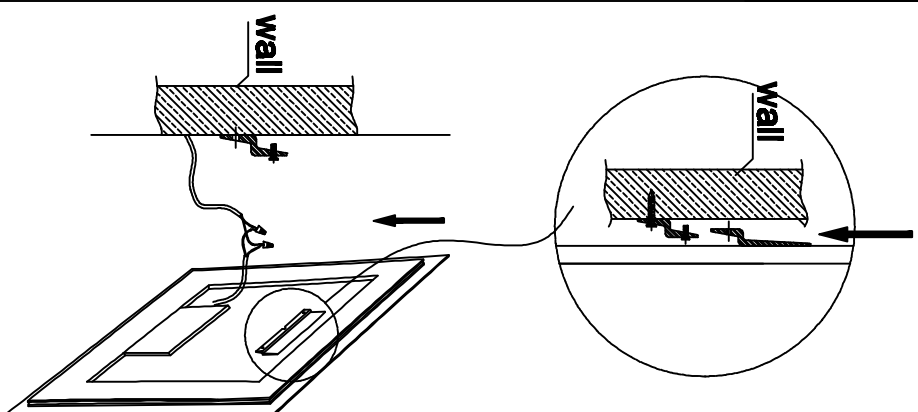
