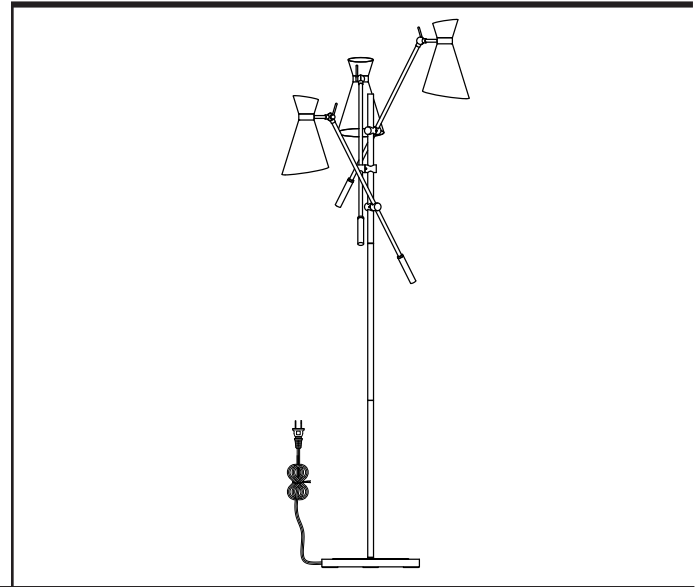

CAUTION: To prevent shock, only plug in lamp after lamp assembly is complete.

WARNING: This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). As a safety feature, this plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not attempt to work around this safety feature.

Before assembly, remove all parts and part packages from box. If anything is missing, please contact the retailer from which the product was purchased.

1. Carefully pull lamp cord from lamp base (A). Pull lamp cord taut. Screw bottom column (B) onto lamp base (A).
2. Screw center column (C) onto top of bottom column (B).
3. Screw top column (D) onto top of center column (C).
4. Thread one handle (E) onto the end of each arm (H).
5. Using hex wrench (F), loosen set screw on connector (G). Adjust arm (H) to desired position. Tighten set screw on connector (G) to secure arm (H) in place. Repeat this step to adjust remaining arms (H).
6. Loosen key (L) at top of arm (H). Adjust shade (K) to desired position. Tighten key (L) to secure shade (K) in place. DO NOT over tighten. Repeat this stem to adjust remaining shades (K).
7. Insert recommended bulbs (not included) into sockets. **WARNING:** Verify correct bulb wattage marked on socket of lamp. DO NOT exceed maximum bulb wattage.
