
ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: Turn off the main power at circuit breaker before installing fixture. AVERTISSEMENT: Coupez la source d'alimentation principale au panneau central de disjoncteurs avant d'installer le luminaire.

NOTE: 1. Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirements. 2. Read and save these instructions.



Turn off the power at fuse or circuit box

- 1. Unscrew the two bolt nuts (D). Remove the two rubber pads (E) and the crossbar unit (A) from the backplate.
- Attach the crossbar unit (A) to the outlet box using two mounting screws (B). Adjust the length of the preinstalled fixture mounting screws if necessary.
 Note: Make sure that the fixture mounting screws are lined up horizontally to make the fixture level.
- 3. Hook the curved arm to the loop, and then attach the curved arm to the back plate by using the set screw, washer and the lock nut.




- 4. Pull out the source wires from the outlet box. Make wire connections using wire connectors (C) as follows:
 - Connect the hot wire (black insulation) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
 - Connect the neutral wire (white insulation) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.
 - Attach the fixture ground wire (bare wire) to the crossbar unit (A) with the green ground screw, then depending on local code, connect it to the house ground wire with the wire connector (C). Carefully put all of the wires back into the outlet box.
- 5. Attach the fixture to the mounting plate unit (A) by inserting headless screws into set holes on backplate, then secure it with two rubber pads (E) and two bolt nuts (D).


NOTE: With silicone caulking compound, caulk complete around the backplate meets with the wall surface to prevent water from seeping into the outlet box.

6. Install a bulb (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum wattage allowed.

Turn on the power at fuse or circuit box

1 Year Warranty
